RACE RULES

- The race must be run in accordance with the rules of ASA and AGN.
- Athletes who are registered for the 10 km and 21.1 km races must wear the ASA 2024 license on the front and the back of the running vest. The official race number must be on the front of the vest and must not cover the logos on the license number.
- Temporary licensed athletes for the 10 km and 21.1 km races must wear the required temporary license at the back of the vest.
- All licensed athletes competing for category prizes must wear numeric category tags clearly visible on the back and front of the vest. Proof of age for prize winners will be required.
- Walkers competing for prize money must wear a clearly visible "W" tag on the front and the back of the vest.
- No seconding is allowed.
- No iPods or any listening devices are allowed.
- No blades, cycles or mechanically operated devices allowed in the race.
- No doas allowed.
- The minimum age for 21.1 km is 16 years and 14 years for 10 km.
- Participants are required to obey the instructions of all traffic officials, race marshals and race referees.
- Runners are not allowed to run in someone else's number. Sustitution allowed at registration only.

GENERAL

- Parking is at your own risk.
- Clubs must use the entrance in Meiring Naude Road, Brummeria, Gate 3, North Gate and must
 please drop off their trailers and gazebos in the designated spots and demarcated areas. Clubs
 are requested to set up Club trailers and gazebos on Friday, 18 October 2024 between 16:00
 and 19:00.
- The gate will be closed for vehicular traffic at 04:30 on race day. Only pedestrians will be allowed access from 4:30 to 11:00.
- A tog bag area will be available.
- Club gazebos are welcome and fire extinguishers are mandatory if a gas braai is used.
- Participation is at own risk. The organizers, sponsors, CSIR or any agents accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury.
- Baby strollers are welcome on the 5 km run. NO strollers allowed on the 10 km and 21.1 km routes as the route profile is not suitable.
- Wheelchair athletes for the 10 km and 21.1km races are not allowed due to the route profile of the race.
- Medical assistance will be available.
- Refreshment stations (water and coke) will be at approximately every 3 km.
- The entry fee is not refundable.
- Please do not litter. Do not discard water sachets or cups in the gardens and drains.
- Any participant who is running 21.1 km who has not reached the Main Gate at 08:15 will not be permitted to complete the race. This is for safety reasons.
- The cut-off time is 09:15.











PRIZE MONEY

- No category tag, no prize money
- All prize money will be paid via eft on the first business day after the race, proof of banking details to be supplied at prize giving
- Category winners must be present at prize giving to be eligible to receive the prize money.
